**WHEREAS**, the City desires to make technology enhancements by running fiber optic wiring from City Hall to city-owned building that houses the City's Public Works department (collectively hereinafter "Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that ComTech Fiber is the best use of City funds for the completion of the Project; and


**WHEREAS**, the City staff is recommending that the City award a contract not to exceed \$88,000.00 to ComTech Fiber for completion of the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the City's best interest to authorize the Council to award the contract to ComTech Fiber and authorize the Mayor or his designee to sign the same;


